Since 2004 Connecticut has established more than 150 school partnerships with Shandong Province, Connecticut's sister province since 1986. This application for a twelve-day field study in Beijing and Shandong Province, hosted by your sister school, is designed to strengthen existing school partnerships. The focus for the 2013 program will be on Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) which offers the promise of students learning in an interdisciplinary way that couples rigorous standards to real world experience allowing students to apply these disciplines in contexts that make connections between school, community, work and their world. The 2013 Principal Shadowing Program will focus on how China develops the knowledge base for students to excel in these disciplines and create innovation in the growth of their economy. We can guarantee that your participation in the Principal and Teacher Shadowing Project will provide the experience of a lifetime. The anticipated cost per participant for the program is \$1,850.00 for double occupancy plus \$160 for Chinese visa. The price includes a \$500 scholarship for the first 20 eligible participants who apply.
