LTC 501 Athletic Administration: Philosophy, Leadership Organizations and Professional Programs** **Instructor - Joe Tonelli**

This flagship course of Leadership Training serves as an overview for the interscholastic athletic administration. This course focuses on the roles of the NFHS, the NIAAA, the State Athletic/Activity Associations, and the State Athletic Administrator's Associations. The course also previews the NIAAA Certification Program and the NIAAA Leadership Training Program. It is a prerequisite for all levels of certification and includes study materials for the CAA Certification Examination. Required for: RAA, CAA and CMAA Certification

LTC 508 Athletic Administration: Legal Issues III - (Hazing, ADA, Employment Law)**

Instructor - Paul Mengold

This course will have in-depth coverage of the issues and strategies related to the development of an effective policy for prevention of hazing in an interscholastic athletics program; coverage of the constitutional and statutory issues affecting athletics programs, including the impact of disabilities legislation on school athletics; and coverage of employment law concerns affecting athletics programs, including contract law, equal pay, and FLSA issues.
