The State Board of Education is considering the adoption of Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS) as one pillar in a statewide effort to improve STEM education and keep Connecticut's students nationally and globally competitive. During this preadoption phase, the State Department of Education plans expanded engagement with a group of stakeholders regarding the implications, benefits and challenges of adopting NGSS. The goal is to engender the same broad-based support that the recently-adopted Social Studies Framework received.

The medium for the interactive presentation will be a webinar on Tuesday, May 26, 2015, from 3:00 – 4:00 p.m. The purpose of this webinar is to give a select group of CAS secondary school principals (high school and middle school boards) an overview of the NGSS standards, respond to questions, and collect feedback.
