Charlene works with school districts on mathematics curriculum and professional development and is involved from the curriculum aspect of the development of the mathematics CMT and CAPT.

....is a language arts consultant with the CT State Department of Education. Patricia has been in education for over 20 years. Her teaching experience ranges from pre-k to 12 in both the urban and suburban districts.
