Crucial REOPENING Round Table Conversation for Preschool and Kindergarten Administrators

Thursday, August 6, 2020 | 9:00-10:30 AM

- Can 3-5 year olds socially distance?
- Are masks scary for young children?
- How do we implement enhanced health and safety Covid-19 requirements AND provide learning experiences?

The RESC Alliance, in collaboration with the CT State Department of Education and CAS, is inviting elementary principals in partnership with their preschool program leaders to participate in an early childhood networking opportunity. As efforts continue in planning for re-opening, it is important to consider the needs of all of our youngest learners including implications for children with special needs and other vulnerable populations.

On August 6 at 9:00 AM, please join us for a 90-minute focused conversation about issues specific to young children and a successful reopening of schools. A panel of administrators from school districts that provided in-person ESY services over this summer and community-based, early childhood program administrators from programs that remained open for onsite learning through spring and summer will describe how they addressed logistics of serving young children during the pandemic.

Participants will have an opportunity to ask questions of the panel. In addition, resources to support reopening plans will be shared and participants will have an opportunity to meet with a RESC early childhood specialist in small discussion groups and share district reopening plans with each other.

This will be the first in a monthly series of round table discussions for preschool and kindergarten administrators. Look for more details in the next two weeks!
