CAS is pleased to announce that, in the wake of the pandemic, the 2021-2022 coaching model offers expanded options to provide customized coaching that meets the individual needs of school leaders. CAS will ensure that the district and school goals are coordinated and will be supported by coaches through onsite/virtual visits and ongoing communication. Coaches are highly qualified, trained administrators who meet periodically in a community of practice to continue to develop their coaching skills.

The American Rescue Plan - ESSER or Title II Part A funds may be used to cover the cost of coaches.

Available services include:

- Assigning a coach to one school leader to focus on individual school needs
- Coaching several school leaders in different schools to build capacity and connect individuals and teams through shared goals and a common vision of the work
- Working with REL Northeast & Islands to support accelerated learning and to increase equity by providing evidence-based resources and coaching
- Strengthening critical leadership and managerial skills including collaboration, authenticity, resilience and value-based decision making
- Developing conflict resolution strategies and proactive solutions
- Encouraging and offering time for heightened self-reflection and self-regulation
- Data and evidence will be collected to demonstrate positive benefits of having a coach.

A mid-year and final assessment will be completed to monitor and identify progress. Additionally, data and evidence demonstrating the positive benefits of having a coach will be collected.
