The Connecticut Association of Schools takes great pleasure in announcing the CAS Volunteer Recognition Banquet to be held on March 7, 2016, at 5:00 p.m. at the Aqua Turf Club in Southington.

All registrations (award recipients, family members, school personnel) must be completed electronically via the CAS-CIAC web site at www.casciac.org. To submit your information, select the CAS website and click on member login at the top of the page.

- Enter your *school number and login ID* then hit *continue*.
- After successfully logging in, select:
View/Submit Volunteer Recognition Banquet Reservation Form.
- Complete the reservation request form, and when finished, hit *submit*.

Be sure to indicate the names of the volunteers your school will recognize and include three sentences describing their contributions. You will receive an immediate email response to confirm your reservation.

The date of this banquet falls at the very beginning of the second week of March, and it is imperative that all reservations be received no later than the deadline of February 19, 2016.

We are unable to accommodate registrations after the deadline or admit anyone into the banquet that has not been previously registered by the school principal. It is expected that a large number of CAS schools will participate. Schools will be seated on a first-come first-served basis. We will reserve individual tables for schools sending groups of 10. Smaller groups will be seated with participants from another school. An early response will ensure priority seating.
