Dear Principal:

On behalf of the Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE) and the Connecticut Association of Schools (CAS), I am inviting you to a year-long leadership training program, *The Principals' Leadership Series*, which is designed for school-based leaders in Connecticut.

Building on successful programs in previous years, the foundation for the 2014-2015 Series remains the McREL research document, *Simply Better: Doing What Matters to Change the Odds for Student Success*. The format has been designed so that at each session a presenter will cover the key elements of the McREL document. Each presentation will be followed by a facilitated discussion about the application of the content to each participant's school and school district. Relating the presentations and discussions to the current research on school and district improvement, as well as highlighting the alignment to their current alliance district improvement plans, will be central to this work.

CAS Executive Coaches will serve as facilitators for each of the cohorts of 12 to 14 principals/assistant principals with the CAS coach remaining with the same cohort throughout the series. To the extent practicable, participants will be grouped by school level. I expect that 50 school leaders will participate.
