**Price Per Person:**

US\$2350 per person for double occupancy (Hartford or New York Departure)

Minimum of 15 participants required for listed price.

**The price includes:**

- 1.) Chinese visa fees (US\$130 per person);
- 2.) International Economy-class flights to Beijing and return;
- 3.) 4 star hotels in-China based on double occupancy as specified in the itinerary;
- 4.) In-China express trains and buses as specified in the itinerary;
- 5.) All entrance fees, meals, private chartered buses, tour guides as specified in the itinerary; and
- 6.) All tips in China for tour guides, bus drives, and luggage handlers.

**The price does NOT include:**

- 1) Travel Insurance (strongly advised, about US\$50 per person);
- 2) All personal expenses such as: excess baggage charges, extra beverages, laundry, telephone calls, insurance and expenses not specified in the itinerary; and
- 3) \$350 supplement for single room occupancy.

**Payment Due Dates:**

1. Full payment of \$1,850 or \$2,350 is due by February 6, 2010. Payment not received by February 6th may be subject to increase cost for airfare.
2. Once international air travel is purchased, the ticket is not refundable unless with a medical excuse. If so, the penalties can be up to \$350 per ticket for cancellation with a medical reason.
3. Add \$350 for single room request. The in-China portion of payment is refundable with 30% penalty if notice is given 14 days prior to the trip; 50% penalty if cancellation notice is given 7 days prior to the trip; 70% penalty if cancellation notice is given 1-3 days prior to the trip. No refund will be available after the trip starts on the departure day.

**Send Payments to:** There is a \$500 subsidy to offset the full cost of this trip. The grant subsidy reduces the cost to \$1,850 per person for double occupancy. Send payment to:
