



Complementary Observers: Capturing the Reality and Lessons from the Field

Educator evaluation is providing many opportunities for professional learning throughout the structure and process. Schools in Connecticut have been redesigning evaluation plan implementation strategies that provide benefits for both teachers and administrators.
