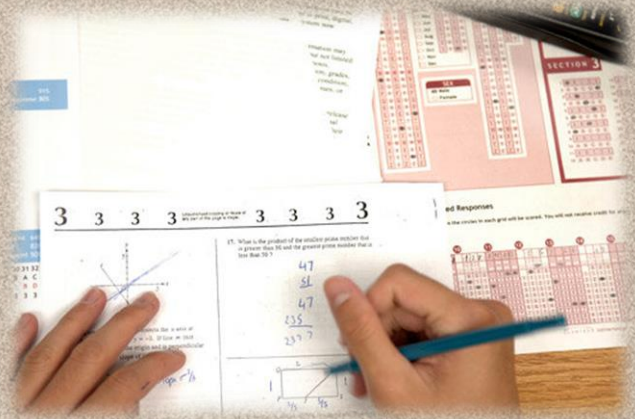


The Redesigned SAT and PSAT/NMSQT: What School Administrators Need to Know

In this workshop, Alan Bernstein, the College Board's Senior District Director, will explain the substantive changes in the SAT and PSAT/NMSQT that will take place beginning next October (2015) with the redesigned PSAT. (The redesigned SAT will be administered in the Spring of 2016). He will explain how the redesigned tests will be closely linked to rigorous college readiness standards, such as the Common Core State Standards. He will also explain what these changes will mean for parents, teachers, and, most important, students.

Finally, Bernstein will explain how the College Board, having moved beyond its traditional focus on admissions and acceptance, has redesigned its programs to include the College Board Opportunity Agenda, which links assessment, instruction, and equity in ways that afford all students valuable opportunities after high school. Along those lines, he will explain several of the no-cost resources that are built into College Board assessments for immediate use and others that will be available in coming months.

This program is designed for high school principals and assistant principals, as well as English, mathematics and guidance department leaders of *CAS Member Schools* and district superintendents and assistant superintendents.
