	The principal ensures that information gained from the data team process is used to differentiate and tier instruction for SRBI.	
	The principal uses student data to inform decisions about Professional development	
	The principal attends one data team meeting per month	
	The principal ensures fidelity to the DDDM/DT process.

	The principal ensures that meetings are videotaped so that all members can engage in reflection of the process.

	The principal schedules so that instructional data teams meet at least twice a month.	
	The role of the instructional team leader is assumed by a teacher.	
	The principal expects that the teams will adhere to the data team protocol including norms, roles, agendas and the five-step process, i.e. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Collecting and Charting Data 2. Analyze Data and Student Work 3. Set SMART goals 4. Select Effective Teaching Strategies 5. Determine Results Indicators 	
	The principal expects that team members come with disaggregated data and student work.	
	The principal is knowledgeable about CFA's and ensures that they are an integral part of the work.	
	Instructional strategies are agreed upon and are based on the data.	
	Principal monitors the implementation of the agreed upon strategies through observation and artifacts (lesson plans and student work)	
	The principal monitors the data team process (attends meetings, reads minutes, provides feedback)	
	The principal monitors that the DDDM/DT process informs lesson planning.	
	The principal is perceived as a supportive, knowledgeable resource.	

	The principal makes space available for teams to post and maintain data walls.	
	Minutes are stored and accessible to all teams.
