\$1,000.00 SCHOLARSHIPS

Dear Principal,

The Connecticut High School Coaches Association will award its annual \$1,000 scholarships to high school scholar-athletes. Graduating seniors from CIAC member schools who meet the following requirements are eligible:

1. Have earned at least one varsity athletic letter.
2. Have achieved a minimum 3.0 academic average.
3. Have demonstrated exemplary citizenship and leadership.

Each principal may nominate one graduating senior boy and one graduating senior girl from their school. The Coaches Association will be presenting six (6) \$1,000 scholarships to the top three boys and three girls selected by our non-coaching committee. One other change to be noted is that only one winner from a school can be awarded a scholarship.

Nominations must be submitted on the Official CHSCA Scholar-Athlete forms and contain the signatures of the principal and athletic director verifying the accuracy of the data provided. Applications must be returned no later than Friday, February 10, 2006. Send applications to:
