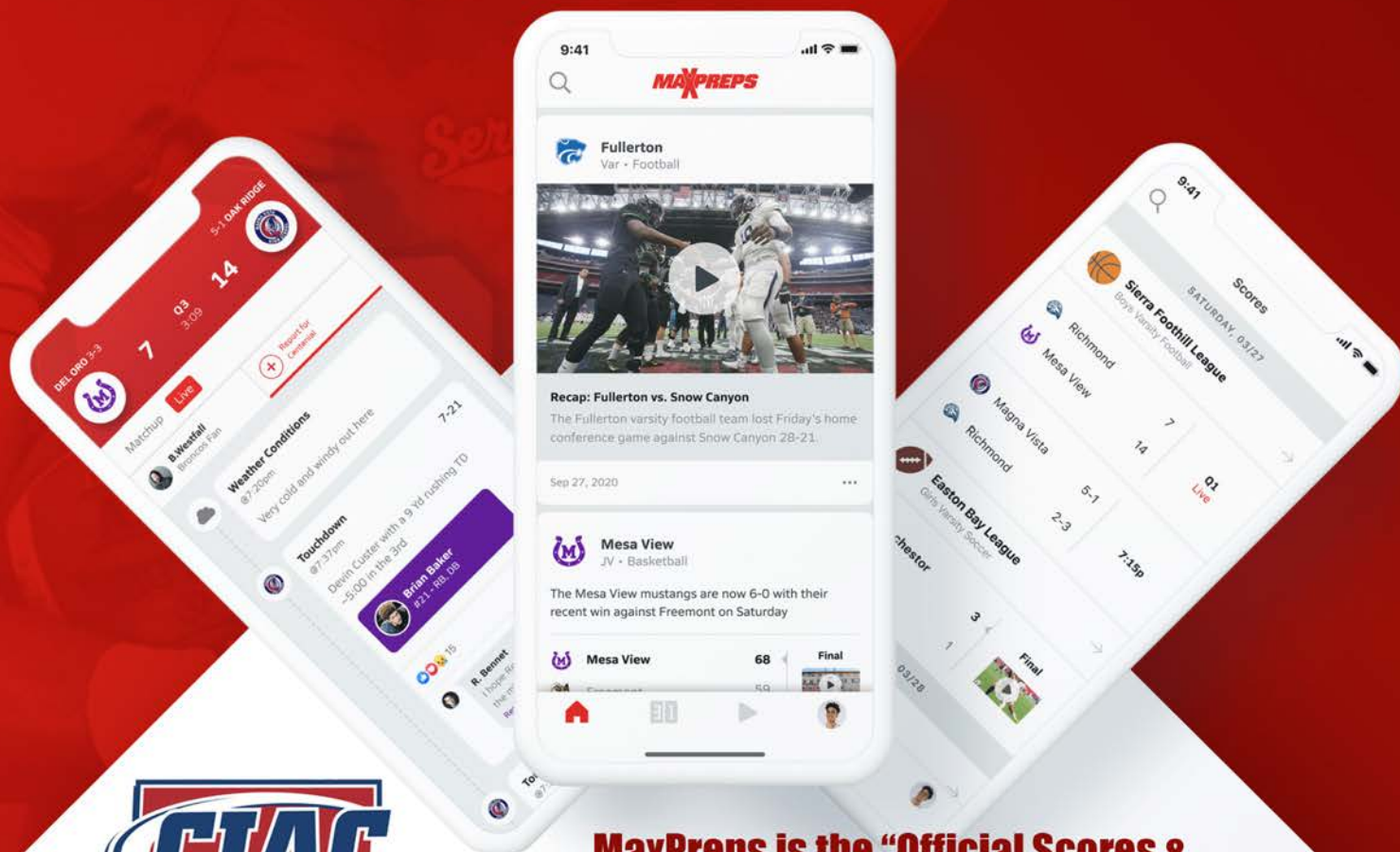

2022 CIAC ICE HOCKEY HONOREE THOMAS NAEGLE



Dr. Thomas Neagle has over forty years of educational leadership experience in both private and public schools in Connecticut. Throughout his years as a school administrator, he was a dedicated and influential member of CAS-CIAC, serving in several prominent leadership roles, including chair of the CIAC Eligibility Committee, the Out of Season Coaching Committee and the Season Limitation Committee. It is, however, his thirty-one years as member and chair of the CIAC Ice Hockey Committee which comprise his greatest contributions and reflect his richest legacy. His impact on the sport of CIAC ice hockey can still be felt today.

Dr. Neagle, or “Mr. Hockey”, as he was known at Notre Dame West Haven, began serving on the Ice Hockey Committee in 1988.

His involvement and passion for the sport can be traced to his days at Notre Dame West Haven, when the school’s young athletic director (Joe Tonelli) asked the administration for more oversight at games. Dr. Neagle’s oversight role at games turned into a love of the game and eventually landed him on the CIAC Ice Hockey Committee. He served as the chair of the committee from 1996-2019 and his tireless efforts helped to advance the sport of ice hockey and bring it to the level of prestige it now enjoys. Dr. Neagle’s contribution to interscholastic ice hockey and his impact on the thousands of athletes who play the sport, are so great that it would be impossible to capture them here.

Dr. Neagle views serving on the CIAC Ice Hockey Committee as one of the highlights of his career in education. Sports in general are a great avenue for student athletes to be engaged in their school community. For Dr. Neagle, the ice hockey community is a fraternity, which includes student athletes, coaches, officials, and spectators. He loves walking into a rink and greeting all of the people who make up this fraternity. Dr. Neagle values the relationships with friends and colleagues that have developed through the years because of the sport. Although he does not like the cold weather, he believes the only redeeming part of the winter is ice hockey.
