Dear CAS Member Principal:

The Nineteenth Annual Connecticut High School Scholar-Athlete Awards Program will be held on Sunday, May 5, 2002, at the Aqua Turf Club, Southington, at 5:00 p.m.

Included in this mailing you will find all needed information which will enable you to select your students for the 2002 Scholar-Athlete Awards and to make reservations for the banquet.

PROGRAM

I am very pleased to announce that the program for the banquet this year will again feature black and white photographs and brief descriptions of all 2002 honorees. As you can imagine, the preparation of this program requires considerable time and effort. Time lines have to be advanced and specific information is needed from you. I'm sure, however, that you will agree that the provision of this excellent program is well worth the efforts involved.

QUALIFICATION CRITERIA:

1. Each scholar-athlete must be a graduating senior.
2. Each scholar-athlete must possess a cumulative grade point average of no less than 3.5 or its equivalent on a scale of 1-4 or its equivalent.
3. Each scholar-athlete must have participated in a CIAC-sponsored varsity sport in Connecticut for a minimum of two years.
4. Each scholar-athlete must have exhibited outstanding school and community service
5. Each scholar-athlete must possess high levels of integrity, self-discipline and courage with personal standards which serve as a model to others.
5. Only one male and one female scholar athlete may be selected.

COSTS:

The scholar-athletes themselves, as honored guests of CAS-CIAC, and patrons (a patron contributes \$150) will receive complimentary tickets.

TICKETS for family, school officials and CAS-CIAC Board members and spouses are available at \$33.00 per person. (There is a maximum of ten (10) seats per school including family, officials, patron and scholar-athletes.)

The honorees' form with names of the scholar-athletes, their descriptions/biographies and photographs must be mailed to CAS by Monday, February 18, 2002. The reservation form for others attending and the patron form must be mailed to CAS by Friday, April 5, 2002. (This form is welcome on February 18 for schools which wish to complete the process together.)

Your understanding and cooperation are very much appreciated. Tickets and other information will be mailed to the member schools during the last week in April.

NOTE: Principals are asked to be sure to list themselves and their spouses on the registration form under others attending -- if they are planning to attend.

The scholar-athlete must be accompanied by adults (parents and/or school officials).
