**B. FORFEITURE FOR TARDINESS AND COACHES' POOR WEATHER PROCEDURE:**

In the absence of extenuating circumstances, players forfeit the match if they are not ready to play at the scheduled time, as determined by the site director. In case of poor weather conditions, the coach has the responsibility of checking the CIAC web site, contacting the proper tournament official, and/or site director.

**C. SUPERVISION AND PRINCIPALS' RESPONSIBILITIES FOR BOTH CLASS AND OPEN TOURNAMENTS:**

1. Each team must be accompanied and supervised by their head coach or assistant coach or appointed individual. In the event of an unforeseen emergency, the team can be accompanied and supervised by an individual appointed, in writing, by the principal of the school.
2. **ONLY the team's coach may coach his/her players during the odd-game change-over periods and after split sets.**
2. The coach (or appointee) is responsible for supervising the entire team as well as its fans.
3. Contestants must conform to the eligibility rules of the CIAC.
4. **All Qualifiers for the State Open are expected to participate.**

**D. QUALIFICATIONS BASED ON SEASONAL RECORD:**

1. ***For S Division*** -- If a team wins at least 50% of its scheduled matches as of May 22, 2008 it may send a maximum of seven (7) players, three singles and two doubles.
2. ***For M Division*** -- If a team wins at least 50% of its scheduled matches as of May 22, 2008 it may send a maximum of nine (9) players, four singles and two doubles, or three singles and three doubles.
3. ***For L & LL Divisions*** -- If a team wins at least 50% of its scheduled matches as of May 22, 2008 it may send a maximum of ten (10) players, five singles and two doubles or four singles and three doubles.
4. ***For Individuals*** (when the team does not win 50%) --
  - a. If your #1 or #2 singles players or the #1 doubles team wins at least 50% of their seasonal matches as of May 22, 2008 your school may enter one singles player or one doubles team.
  - b. If any two of your #1, #2, or #3 singles players win at least 50% of their seasonal matches as of May 22, 2008 your school may enter a maximum of three players in this possible arrangement: two singles players or one singles player and one doubles team.  
(OR)  
If one of your top two singles players and, in addition, one of your top two doubles teams wins 50% of their seasonal matches as of May 22, 2008 your school may enter one singles player and one doubles team.
  - c. If all three of your top three singles players or both of your #1 or #2 doubles teams wins at least 50% of their seasonal matches as of May 22, 2008 your school may enter a maximum of four players in this possible arrangement -- two singles players and one doubles team or two doubles teams, or three singles players.

**E. ENTRY LIMITATIONS:**

No entrant may play in both singles and doubles.

F. **FEES, ENTRY FORM AND TEAM RECORD SHEET AND THEIR MAILING:**

1. Your entry form and tennis record sheet must be submitted via the password-protected online eligibility center -- no later than Friday, May 23, 2008 by 12:00 p.m.
  2. CIAC Late Entry Policy
    - **No tournament entries will be accepted after the established deadline except those approved by the CIAC Board of Control.**
    - Corrections requested by a school to an entry form that was submitted by the established deadline but prior to seeding/pairing data being published on the web site, will be assessed a fee of \$50 per correction to a maximum of \$250.
    - All requests for corrections must be submitted on a support ticket via the online eligibility center. **No phone request will be considered.**

Tournament Regulations Violations – If a school fails to comply with tournament regulations and such requires the CIAC tournament sports committee, central office staff, or the CIAC Board of Control to redo any portion of the tournament pairings or such non-compliance adversely impacts the management of the tournament, an administrative violation fee of \$500 will be imposed upon the school before entry into the tournament will be allowed.
  3. 2008 Boys Tennis Game Results – Match results must be submitted on a weekly basis (scores for all games through Saturday must be entered no later than the following Monday via the password-protected online eligibility center). Regardless of regular season postponed matches, the date of Thursday, May 22, 2008 is the final day to count for the tournament. All match results must be submitted no later than 12:00 p.m. on Friday, May 25, 2007. All matches canceled should be reported on the tournament entry in place of a score. Principals **MUST** file canceled game/forfeit form if match is to be counted.
  4. 2008 Boys Tennis Tournament Rosters – Must be submitted via the password-protected online eligibility center by 12:00 Noon, Friday, May 23, 2008. Any request for changes after the initial roster is submitted must be made on a “support ticket” via the online eligibility center.
  5. The entry fee will be \$60.00, plus \$5.00 per individual competitor. There is no additional fee for alternates. Make the check payable to the CIAC and mail it to the CIAC office, 30 Realty Drive, Cheshire, CT 06410.
  6. Please indicate the record of each player and his position on your team on the entry form and team record sheet. Comments concerning outstanding players are also requested. This information **WILL HELP** in determining seeded players.
  7. Alternates must fill in the spot vacated by the non-participating entries in the class tournament to avoid last minute shifting of line-ups on the draw sheet. **HIS NAME MUST APPEAR ON THE ENTRY FORM.**
  8. 2008 Boys Tennis Schedule – Must be submitted via the password-protected online eligibility center. (Final submission due by February 8, 2008) Failure to submit schedule of games may result in disqualification from the tournament. All matches must be reported. Matches not reported may not be considered for tournament qualification.

G. **PAIRINGS AND LIMITS ON MATCHES PLAYED:**

1. **(New) Class draws will be available online (casciac.org) by noon, Wednesday, May 28, 2008. Approximate start times will be noted.**
2. A participant may not play more than three doubles matches or two singles matches on any given day in the Class Tournaments.

**H. TENNIS ATTIRE AND TENNIS BALLS:**

1. Appropriate tennis attire is mandatory and is subject to the director's or coordinator's approval.
2. **The CIAC will supply tennis balls c/o Wilson Sporting Goods.** A new can will only be available for the third set in the later rounds.

**I. TEAM SCORING:**

1. In the class tournaments, points for the team scores will be awarded for each event (singles and doubles) on the following basis: one point for each match won. In the case of a bye in the first round, no point shall be awarded unless the player or doubles team wins the next round match, in which case two points shall be awarded, one for the bye and one for the next round that has been won.
2. All matches during the class tournaments will be settled by two out of three sets, with a twelve-point tie-break when the set(s) reach six-all. Preliminary matches (above 64 draw) will be settled by a ten-point tie-breaker in lieu of a third set.

**J. AWARDS:*****For Class Tournaments:***

1. **By Schools** -- In each class, the school that accumulates the highest number of combined points in singles and doubles will receive a winner's trophy for the school. The school that acquires the next highest number of combined total points will receive the runner-up trophy. (Total of eight (8) trophies).
2. **By Individuals** -- In both singles and doubles, the individual winners and runners-up will merit and receive corresponding medals. (Total of 24 awards)

**K. RULES OF CONDUCT, PLAY AND INJURY:**

1. The game will be governed by the USTA Code of Conduct, including the point penalty system, with modifications as specified by the CIAC Tennis Committee. In case of any controversy the decision of the site director shall be final. Warm-ups will be a maximum of ten minutes. Up to a ten (10) minute break will be allowed between second and third sets. One 5 minute injury time out is allowed with an equitable and reasonable extension or reduction of the 5 minute injury time determined by the site director.
2. Participants will follow all of the rules in the Class and Open Tournaments of this information sheet and entry form.

**A. QUALIFICATIONS FOR ENTRY INTO THE STATE OPEN TOURNAMENT**

1. All contestants must have conformed to the rules of the CIAC Class Tennis Tournaments.
2. All singles and doubles finalists, in all Class tournaments, qualify for the Open and **are expected to participate**. If a qualifier cannot participate, his coach must inform the tournament officials immediately upon qualifying. The directors will select a substitute from the semi-finalists of the Class Tournaments. (Note #6: In order to receive **Player of the Year** award and participate in the New England Championships, the qualifier must participate in the State Open.
3. The qualifying players' coach or designee must contact the tournament director to confirm the player's participation in the Open.
4. In the Open, only the team's coach or his/her designee may coach his/her players during the odd game change over periods and rest periods during the ten minutes of split sets.
5. All players must be accompanied by the team coach or principal's designee (in writing). The coach/designee is responsible for the conduct of all players and team fans.
6. A player must participate in the Open to qualify for the New England Championships and to receive the **Player of the Year** award.

**B. THE OPEN FORMAT AND SCORING FOR SINGLE AND DOUBLES:****1. Format**

There will be a round robin of eight singles players and eight doubles teams who are the finalists from the class tournaments (or appointed substitutes). The players/teams will be divided into two flights of four. In each flight players will play a Round Robin against each other. The winners and second place finishers of each flight qualify for the semi-finals against the other flight (1 x 2) to be played at 3:30, Monday, June 9. The finals will occur at 3:30, Tuesday, June 10. (Rain date, 3:30, Wednesday, June 11.)

**2. Scoring**

Players will play an eight-game pro-set match, regular scoring with each of the other three players/teams in the flight. There will be a 12 point tie-breaker at 8-8. The winner of the most number of matches in the flight will be in the number one position for the semi-finals, and the second place finisher will take the number two position. In the case of a tie, the head-to-head result will determine the winner. **Semi-finals and Finals will consist of two-out-of-three sets with a twelve point tie-breaker at 6-6.** The tournament directors reserve the right to modify scoring depending on weather conditions.

C. **AWARDS**

**For State Open Tournament** -- The winners and runners-up in singles and doubles will receive awards. (Six awards)

This premier event culminates the high school tennis season and draws participants from all New England states. Each state may send two players in each of boys and girls, singles and doubles, and one alternate per event (total of 3 entries per event). Each state determines its criteria for selection to participate. In Connecticut, the finalists of the State Open for boys and girls are awarded placement. The alternates are invited by the State Tournament Director according to: progress in the State Open, Class Tournament and/or availability and recommendation of the tennis committees. Coaches must notify the New England Tournament Director of their players' intention and desire to participate by Tuesday, June 10, 2008.

## **DIRECTIONS TO TENNIS SITES:**

### **Conard High School, West Hartford**

I-84 West - Exit 41 - Take Right off exit - Take left at Light on to Beechwood Road - Conard is 2 blocks on right.

I-84 East - Exit 41 - Take left off exit - Go to 2nd light - make left on Beechwood Road - Conard is 2 blocks on right.

### **Wm. Hall High School, West Hartford**

I-84 West - Exit 41 - Take right off exit ramp - This is South Main Street - Go 4.8 miles - School is on the left.

I-84 East - Exit 41 - Take left off exit ramp - This is South Main Street - Go 4.8 miles - School is on the left.

### **Wesleyan University, Middletown**

From Hartford and North – Take I-91 south through Hartford to exit 22S (left-hand exit). This exit is for Route 9 south to Middletown. At exit 15 (second light), turn right onto Route 66 West (also called Washington Street).

From New Haven and South – Traveling on I-91 north, take exit 18 (66 East) or Traveling on Merritt/Wilbur Cross Parkway (Route 15 north), take exit 68 to Route 691/66 East. Route 66 becomes Washington Street in Middletown.

From Waterbury and West – Traveling on I-84 East, take exit 27 to Route 691/66 East. Route 66 E. becomes Washington Street in Middletown.

From New London and Southeast – Travel on Route 95 North to Route 9 North in Old Saybrook. Follow Route 9 north all the way to Middletown and turn left at the first traffic light in Middletown (Route 66 West).

From Willimantic and East – Travel on Route 66 West all the way to Portland. Go over the bridge to Middletown, which puts you on Main Street. Stay on Main Street to third light, which is for Route 66 West (Washington Street). Turn right on Washington Street.

**FROM I-95 HEADING NORTH** – Take Exit 44, bear right. Take first left onto Ella T. Grasso Boulevard (Route 10). Follow Ella T. Grasso Boulevard for 2 miles to Route 34 (Derby Avenue). Take left onto Route 34 at light, when you see Subway on the right. Go through one light, past the stone pillars of the Walter Camp Gate, and past the next (brick) building. Take a right into the entrance driveway, immediately after the wall, in front of the brick building. If you come to another (second) traffic light, at Central Avenue, you've missed it.

**FROM I-95 HEADING SOUTH** – Take Exit 45, continue straight onto Ella T. Grasso Boulevard (Route 10). Follow Ella T. Grasso Boulevard 2.2 miles to Route 34 (Derby Avenue). Take left onto Route 34 at light, when you see Subway on the right. Go through one light, past the stone pillars of the Walter Camp Gate, and past the next (brick) building. Take a right into the entrance driveway, immediately after the wall in front of the brick building. If you come to another (second) traffic light, at Central Avenue, you've missed it.

**FROM I-91 HEADING SOUTH** – Take Exit 1 -- Downtown New Haven -- This becomes Route 34. Follow Route 34 West to Exit 3. This exit will not turn, but will continue you straight on Route 34. Continue straight on Route 34 West, after Exit 3, until the road ends, and you must take a left or right. Take a right at this light onto Ella T. Grasso Boulevard. Follow Ella T. Grasso Boulevard only 1/4 mile, to the next traffic light (Route 34). Take a left on Route 34 (at light, you will see Subway on the right). Go through one light, past the stone pillars of the Walter Camp Gate, and past the next (brick) building. Take a right into the entrance driveway, immediately after the wall in front of the brick building. If you come to another (second) traffic light, at Central Avenue, you've missed it.

**FROM ROUTE 15 HEADING NORTH** – Take Exit 58, (Route 34 East) toward West Haven. This becomes Route 34 East (Derby Avenue).
