2015-2016 CIAC ICE HOCKEY HONOREE BO HICKEY



Bo Hickey retired after 20 years as the varsity ice hockey coach at New Canaan High School. Hickey, who was an assistant football coach at New Canaan for 31 years, and who played for the Denver Broncos in the late 1960s, became the Rams head hockey coach midseason in 1994. The Rams, who were 1-7 at that point, went on to win the FCIAC championship.

Hickey coached a total of 20 seasons at New Canaan; his teams won 10 FCIAC titles and played in six state championship games. Although New Canaan never won a state championship, his 1999 team played in the famous five-overtime, two-day classic against Notre Dame-Fairfield. New Canaan lost that game 3-2 in the 37th minute of overtime.

Bo coached two undefeated regular season teams – one in 1998-99 and again in 2010-11. A large number of his players went on to successful university and professional careers. Most notable was Montreal Canadian forward Max Pacioretty.

To appreciate Bo Hickey and his wonderful success over two decades as the Rams varsity hockey coach, one should understand that Hickey's a unique individual. His genius was in taking young players and making them better people and better athletes. As Bo says, "the kids all knew where they stood with me and the biggest thing I did for them was to make sure we held them accountable for their actions. All high school coaches demand respect and to get respect you have to give respect. As coaches, we tried to get the most out of our kids. I'm not talking about greatness but a growth process where they can have fun playing a great sport."

Coaching, motivating, and helping young people grow into mature adults have been the mantra of the gruff, clearly spoken, and extremely successful coach.

Today, the CIAC Ice Hockey Committee is extremely proud to honor Bo for all his efforts on behalf of his community for the past 30 years.


