



# 2017 - 2018 CIAC ICE HOCKEY HONOREE Robert Melanson



With Canadian roots, Robert Melanson was born with hockey in his blood. The fourth oldest of nine children, Rob grew up in Simsbury, Connecticut, where his father, Alfred Melanson, was one of the founding members of Simsbury Youth Hockey. In addition to Rob's hockey involvement, three brothers are current high school coaches.

Rob started playing hockey at a young age through to the Midget level where he excelled. After high school, Rob played junior hockey for two years. Still wanting to stay involved in the sport, he began volunteering as a referee for West Hartford Youth Hockey and playing in men's hockey leagues. Rob began officiating men's hockey league games and youth games when his construction work was slow. In 1982 he joined the local referee association, the Ice Hockey Officials of Northern Connecticut (IHONC). During the 1988-89 season Rob joined National Ice Hockey Officials Association (NIHOA). In 1992 he was selected to officiate college hockey. He loved traveling throughout New England, working Division I games and making great friends along the way.

Throughout this time Rob's involvement with NIHOA increased. He became the northern commissioner, then was elected the northern director. Rob subsequently served as vice president, president and referee in chief. As referee in chief, he worked with NIHOA, the Connecticut Interscholastic Athletic Conference (CIAC) and high school coaches to improve high school hockey. This was one of his most rewarding experiences of his officiating career.

Rob believes that a successful officiating career occurs when you love what you do, give 100%, be honest, and treat others the way you would want to be treated. When working a game, Rob demands of coaches and players: full communication, sportsmanship and absolute respect for each other.

In addition to officiating high school and college hockey, Rob has traveled to Finland, Czech Republic and Canada to officiate Standing Amputee Hockey World Games. He also had the opportunity of officiating at a Hartford Whalers Old Timers game where the late Gordie Howe was on the ice.

Rob is married to his high school sweetheart, Louise and lives in Bloomfield, Connecticut. They have four grown children and seven grandchildren. After battling cancer and receiving two knee replacements, Rob is back on the ice playing the game he loves and officiating hockey. Nothing keeps him away from the sport.






