For Connecticut High School Students interested in a Law Enforcement Career

SCHOLARSHIPS: Five \$1,000 Scholarships per year

DEADLINE: Submit to your local police chief by March 1, 2022

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Must be in the senior year of study and currently enrolled in an accredited high school program in Connecticut.
- 2. Must be applying for admission to a degree program at an accredited post-secondary institution of higher learning.
- 3. Must need financial aid and without such aid would find it difficult although not necessarily impossible to obtain education.
- 4. Must submit properly completed forms and letters to his/her police chief by March 1, 2022.

AWARD STIPULATION:

- 1. Awards to be used for tuition, fees, texts, supplies and other necessary academic purposes.
- 2. Awards conditioned upon substantiation of admission and expenses.
- 3. A check for \$1,000 to be given to each winner following submission of appropriate documents.

BASIS OF SELECTING WINNERS:

- 1. Each police chief in Connecticut will select the applicants from those submitted in their department and send the applicant's completed forms to the Connecticut Police Foundation by **April 1, 2022.**
- 2. Scholarship winners will then be selected by the Foundation's Awards Committee.
- 3. Winners will be selected on the basis of financial need and dedication to a career in law enforcement.
- 4. Winners will be announced in May.
- 5. Actual award will be made in June each year at the CPCA Annual Meeting.
