Now - May 1, 2024: Complete Testing

Review the <u>ARC Testing Requirements</u> document as soon as possible. Take tests early to ensure that you pass your Subject Area test(s) as soon as possible. Ensure that you take the Praxis Core tests (passing scores not required) or, if applying for the Praxis Core Waiver, submit passing SAT/ACT scores as soon as possible. ETS scoring takes 3-5 weeks and there is a 28-day waiting period for test retakes.

January 15, 2024: Enrollment Opens

The ARC Application is available today! Review the <u>ARC Eligibility Requirements</u>, then begin your online application in the ARC Application Empower Portal. The application includes work and education history, contact information for three (3) professional references who will be contacted via email once you submit the application, your personal statement, resume, and the application fee. Create a timeline to ensure all application materials will be ready for submission before the deadline (05/01/2024) and required test scores are received by (06/01/2024).



January - May 2024: Communication

Once you have submitted an application, frequently check your Empower Application Portal and email to ensure your application materials are being received by the ARC Office. Follow up with references. Reach out to ohe.arc@ct.gov as needed.



May 1, 2024: Online Application Due

The online application deadline is today! The application includes work and education history, contact information for three (3) professional references, personal statement, resume, and the application fee. You must ensure that you pay the application fee and press "submit" on the final page.

Applications will not be accepted after this deadline. All tests should have been taken and test scores received or pending.



June 1, 2024: Final Application Materials Due

This is the final deadline for receipt of **official Praxis Core test scores**, <u>passing subject area test</u> (Praxis II or ACTFL) scores, official transcripts, and completed references ONLY. You need to contact the ohe.arc@ct.gov staff if you see an application material due is not uploaded into your application. Please note that there are no other application materials or late applications will be accepted after this time.
