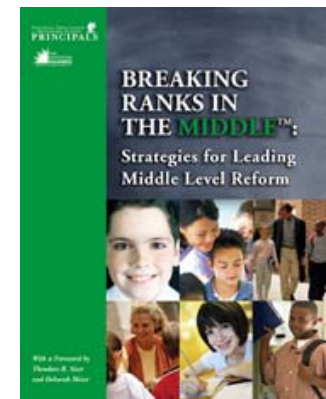

Utilizing the findings and recommendations of the Carnegie Council's *Turning Points 2000* and National Middle School Association's *This We Believe*, the National Association of Secondary School Principals (NASSP) published *Breaking Ranks in the Middle: Strategies for Leading Middle Level Reform (BRIM)*.
