

High school students who are in garage bands, of any style or musical genre, outside of school, are invited to submit an application (available through music teachers and at the website at www.casciac.org under the Student Activities link) plus an audition recording with two songs (originals or covers) by April 28, 2010. All members must be currently enrolled in a Connecticut CAS member high school, (check with a teacher or principal) however, band members do not all need to be enrolled in the same high school. In addition, one member from each band must identify a music teacher (in school or privately) who has made a positive difference in their music education.

Audition recordings, which do not need to be professional, are reviewed by a committee and narrowed down to a maximum of 12 bands per site. The selected bands must be able to perform at either the **Bandjam West** hosted by Darien High School or at the **Bandjam East** at Norwich Free Academy, both taking place on Friday, May 21 from 4:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m.

The bands at each site will compete to receive a grand prize that includes:

- Three (3) hours of professional recording studio time
- > An appearance at the International Festival of Arts and Ideas on the New Haven Green, Elm Street Stage on Saturday, June 26, 2010
- Gift Cards from Sam Ash Music Stores

Judges will be made up of professional musicians and experienced talent managers.



Bands are required to record two of their songs on a CD and submit them with a completed application form and a \$50 entry fee by April 28, 2010. Forms are available from music teachers, high school administrators or on the CAS website: <a href="https://www.casciac.org">www.casciac.org</a> (look in the CSAC Student Activities link).

#### **Competition Rules**

- Applications are open to any musical group formed outside the traditional school music program ensembles and must have two of more members.
- ➤ All members must be currently enrolled in a Connecticut CAS affiliated high school.
- All applicants are required to submit their recording on a CD with two selections, originals or cover songs. Total on state time cannot exceed 15 minutes.
- Lyric sheets for the two songs are required. Please indicate if the song is an original on the lyric sheet.
- ➤ Profane language or performance attire will not be tolerated and will result in disqualification.
- > Bands are expected to respect all of the equipment supplied at the event and the event facility.
- One member of each group is required to identify a music teacher who has influenced their music education.
- > Bands are required to perform the two songs that were submitted with their application.

#### **General Information**

- Up to 12 groups will be selected to perform.
- The competition will be held at both Darien High School and Norwich Free Academy on Friday, May 21, 2010. Details and directions will be sent to the top 12 finalist bands for each site.
- > Should the event be cancelled for any reason, weather or school related issue, bands will be notified by CAS immediately and the event may not be rescheduled. If the event cannot be rescheduled, the band that scores the highest based on the audition recording, will be chosen as the winner for the grand prize. No refunds will be issued.

#### Q. Do all of the members of our band need to be enrolled in the same high school?

**A.** No, but all of the members of your band must be enrolled in a CAS affiliated high school. Most high schools in CT are affiliated with CAS, but check with your principal to make sure.

## Q. If one of our members is in college or has graduated early from high school is he or she eligible to play with our band in the competition?

A. No. All members must be enrolled in a Connecticut High School.

#### Q. Can only rock bands enter?

**A.** The competition is open to bands of all styles, cultures and backgrounds. (rock, pop, country, reggae, jazz....

#### Q. Does it cost anything to enter?

**A.** Each band must submit a \$50 entry fee with their completed application by April 28, 2010. Payable to CAS.

## Q. Will all of the bands who apply be chosen to compete in the May 21, 2010 BandJam competition event?

**A.** A panel of judges will listen to all of the recording of bands who have submitted complete applications and will choose the top 12 bands per site to compete at BandJam '10.
