Workshop Presenter: Alice Mitchell, Director Berlin Upbeat Program

Concluding teaching at Berlin High School, Ms. Mitchell was one of the designers of the Berlin Upbeat Program that she currently directs. Berlin Upbeat is a comprehensive school and community-based character development and leadership training program which involves every school in the town of Berlin. The goal of the program is to encourage the youth of Berlin to develop sound decision making skills and to provide opportunities for positive community involvement and service. As the Director of the program, Ms. Mitchell serves as advisor to the Berlin Upbeat Peer Leadership program which is a student run program at Berlin High School which involves over 250 students. The workshop being presented during the NHS State Conference will focus on the importance of working together in an efficient and effective manner as a planning group. The use of a problem-solving model entitled "Lights-Camera-Action" will be introduced.

If traveling north – at end of the ramp, turn right. At first light turn right. Hotel driveway is on your right.

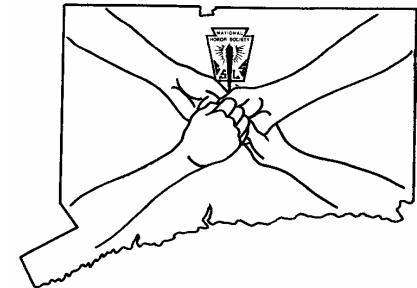
