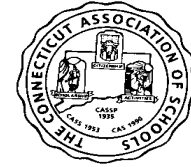
Directions – Hartford Marriott, Rocky Hill

If traveling north – at end of the ramp, turn right. At first light turn right. Hotel driveway is on your right.

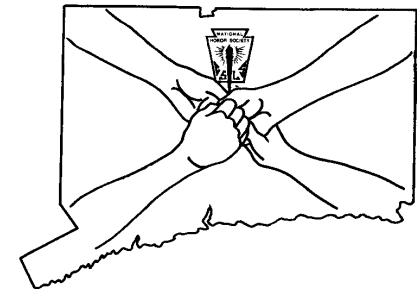
