Election of officers and advisors for the 2017-18 school year will take place at the Annual State Conference scheduled for Friday, May 26th at Trinity College in Hartford, CT.

The officers to be considered are—**President, Secretary, State Social Media and Middle School Representative**. These officers will be selected from member honor societies. The **Vice President** position will be awarded to the student receiving the second highest vote total for president. Voting shall be by ballot and will follow the procedure as set down by the Constitution/By-Laws of this organization. (Article V—Election of Officers). Each school attending the conference shall have two (2) votes per office. Advisory Board candidates will be elected by chapters attending the conference. In the event no candidate has submitted a self-nomination form to run for a specific office, the state association will accept nominations from the floor only for the position for which there is no nominee. Any student being nominated will have to be endorsed by the chapter advisor to be considered as a candidate for office.

All candidates for office must:

- Prepare a three (3) minute oral presentation to be given prior to voting
- Complete the attached self-nominating form to be returned by Monday, May 15, 2017. Any forms postmarked after that date will not be accepted!

Advisors of elected student board members are automatically invited to serve on the State Advisory Board.

Thank you for encouraging chapter members to consider running for office for the CANHS State Advisory Board. The board meets approximately four times during the school year and plans statewide activities.
