2020 CONNECTICUT HIGH SCHOOL RED BURNHAM INVITATIONAL SINGLES BOWLING TOURNAMENT

The CIAC, in cooperation with the Connecticut Bowling Proprietors Association, is sponsoring the Fifth Annual Connecticut High School Singles Bowling Tournament. The tournament will be held on Saturday, January 18, 2020 at the Nutmeg Bowl of Fairfield County. The starting time will be 10:00 a.m.

Your school is invited to participate in the tournament. Here is what you will need to do in order to participate:

1. Individual member school entries will be accepted for the competition. There is no limit to the number of entries per school.

2. The CIAC is considering this event as an activity; therefore, the CIAC will not require each participant to have a physical examination in order to participate. You have the option of requiring an updated physical to participate.

3. The CIAC is not requiring coaches/chaperones to have coaching certification. In the event that bowling is made a CIAC-sponsored sport in the future, coaching certification will then be required.

4. Individuals will bowl four (4) games.

5. Entry Fee - \$20 per entry which will cover all bowling related costs, including the bowling and shoe rentals, if needed. The low cost is made possible through the cooperation of the Connecticut Bowling Proprietors and the Nutmeg Bowl of Fairfield County.

6. The following is a recommended schedule for you to follow if you wish to have your school represented in the bowling tournament.

- Secure approval from your school to participate.
- Determine your entries.

• Register for the tournament as soon as possible, but no later than 4:00 p.m., Monday, January 13, 2020. Mail entry fee (\$20/entrant), the name(s) of your bowler(s) and the name(s) and contact information for your coach/chaperone by January 13, 2020 to CIAC, 30 Realty Drive, Cheshire, CT 06410. Rosters may also be emailed to jsylvester@casciac.org.

• Arrange transportation to the tournament. Schools may wish to join together for the transportation.

• Arrive on time on January 18. Coaches meeting will be at 9:15 a.m. Practice is from 9:40 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and competition begins promptly at 10:00 a.m.

- 7. There will be a dress code in effect for the tournament.
- No plain t-shirts, collared shirts only unless team t-shirts are worn.
- No shorts, no skirts, no YOGA PANTS
- No jeans are permitted. Skorts permitted.
- Proper footwear is required.
- No caps or hats are to be worn.
- Individuals may elect to wear uniform shirts with the school name on them.
- 8. The tournament is open to both boys and girls.

9. The CIAC reserves the right to limit the number of entries once the maximum number of entries is reached.
