Since July 1998, two Grade 12 public school students have been seated on the Connecticut State Board of Education ("Board"). The students, who are appointed by the Governor, serve a one-year term, beginning July 1. This year's student members, Andreea Dinicu of Glastonbury, and Rebecca Salustri of Columbia, have brought unique and valuable perspectives to the Board's deliberations.

We are now beginning the search process for the 2013-14 student Board members. The application package is attached and can be downloaded by accessing the Department's website: [www.state.ct.us/sde](http://www.state.ct.us/sde). **Please inform your students of the 2013-14 application process by posting the "Notice to Grade 11 Students" on a centrally located bulletin board and on your website, and including this information in your "morning announcements."** I would appreciate your distributing this notice to your guidance counselors, PTA presidents, and student council members. Complete application packages must be postmarked on or before March 18, 2013. Applications postmarked after March 18 will not be accepted.

The State Student Advisory Council on Education (SSACE) will review all applications and will select students for an interview. A SSACE panel will conduct interviews in April or May, and will refer five of those individuals to the Governor for his consideration. The Governor will interview the five students and will appoint two students to serve on the Board from July 1, 2013, through June 30, 2014.

Please encourage qualified students in your school to submit their applications. I look forward to your school's participation in this unique opportunity for students. **NOTICE TO GRADE 11 STUDENTS**

***APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP  
ON THE  
CONNECTICUT STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION 2013-2014***

Each year, the Governor appoints two public school students entering their senior year to serve on the Connecticut State Board of Education. Student Board members participate fully in discussions about education policy and lend an important perspective to Board deliberations, although they do not have voting privileges. We encourage you to consider applying for membership on the Board (July 1, 2013, through June 30, 2014).

**ARE YOU QUALIFIED?**

Students who wish to apply for membership on the Board:

- Must be enrolled in a public high school; *and*
- Must have at least a B+ average; *and*
- Will have completed Grade 11 prior to July 1, 2013; *and*
- Must be able to attend monthly all-day meetings in Hartford (usually the first Wednesday of each month).

**HOW TO APPLY**

If you meet all of the above qualifications and wish to apply for membership on the Board, please submit the following: (1) application form; (2) three reference letters from your teachers or school administrators; (3) your resume; and (4) a one-page statement describing your qualifications for appointment to the Board.

**DUE DATE**

Only complete application packages **postmarked on or before March 18, 2013 will be accepted.** Please submit your complete application package to:

**SCREENING PROCESS**

The State Student Advisory Council on Education will review all application packages. Based on its review, the Council will select applicants for interviews to be conducted in April or May. At the conclusion of the interview phase, the Council will recommend five candidates to the Governor for his consideration. The Governor will interview the five finalists, and appoint two students to the Board for a one-year term commencing July 1, 2013.
