Schools may submit more than one project. Please complete a separate form (master copy attached) for each project. Every project submitted will receive a certificate of recognition. The members of SSACE will carefully evaluate and select between 10 and 20 statewide winners. All submissions will be published in a pamphlet and distributed statewide to allow for replication of successful projects.

Awards will be presented in late May or early June. We hope this year every middle and high school in Connecticut will submit at least one project in order to properly recognize the hard work of students who work tirelessly to improve their communities. Thank you.
