Participants will learn how to create a culture of collaboration in schools focused on the right work and centered around common formative assessments and student-centered action plans. Participants will also learn about the different tools available for staff to facilitate, monitor, and coach the learning block process as well as how to support teachers in effectively using a flex block.
