Dear Elementary Level Principal:

The Arts Committee and the Connecticut Association of Schools Elementary Level Board take great pleasure in announcing the **21st ANNUAL ELEMENTARY CELEBRATION OF THE ARTS** on February 10 and 11, 2020, at the Aqua Turf Club in Southington from 5:00 to 7:30 p.m.

OBJECTIVE:

The objective of this program is to recognize students at the elementary level with outstanding ability in the performing or visual arts, as well as maintaining a high level of citizenship and cooperative skills. It is recommended that the students selected for this award be in the last grade within your school.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

To participate in this program, registration must be completed electronically via the CAS-CIAC web site at www.casciac.org. After successfully logging in, select *Submit Elementary Celebration of the Arts Banquet Reservation Form*. MENU AND PROGRAM FOR THE EVENING:

The menu for the celebration will be child oriented. From 5:00 to 6:15 pm, food stations will be located to one end of the banquet room serving tacos, pasta, salad, pizza, and ice-cream. Art-centered activities such as balloon sculpture and face painting will be stationed throughout the banquet room. In addition, caricaturists will be present to create portraits of each award recipient. At 6:15 pm the award ceremony will begin; at 6:45 pm the children will be entertained; and at 7:30 pm the program will end.

COST TO CAS MEMBER SCHOOLS:

The award recipients from CAS-member schools will attend free of charge. Parents, guardians, principals, classroom teachers, music and/or art teachers are also invited to attend at a cost of \$29.00 per person. **Non-member schools** may attend, if space is available. The cost for award recipients from non-member schools will be \$29.00 as well as for each guest who attends with them. Non-member schools will be charged an additional fee of \$100.00 to attend.
