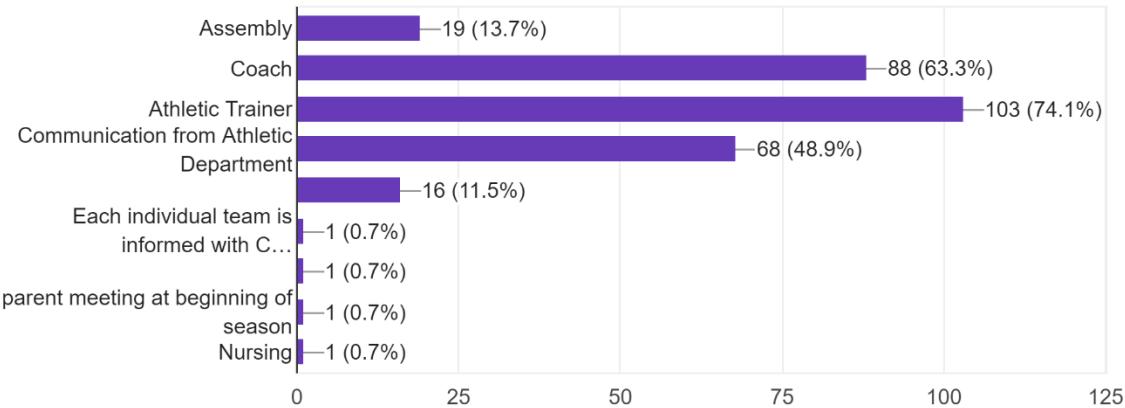


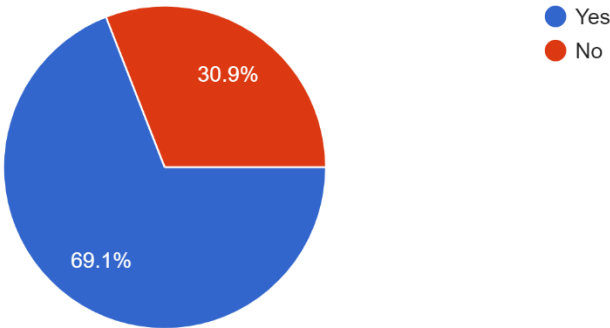
How are student/athletes at your school educated about the prevention of heat related issues?

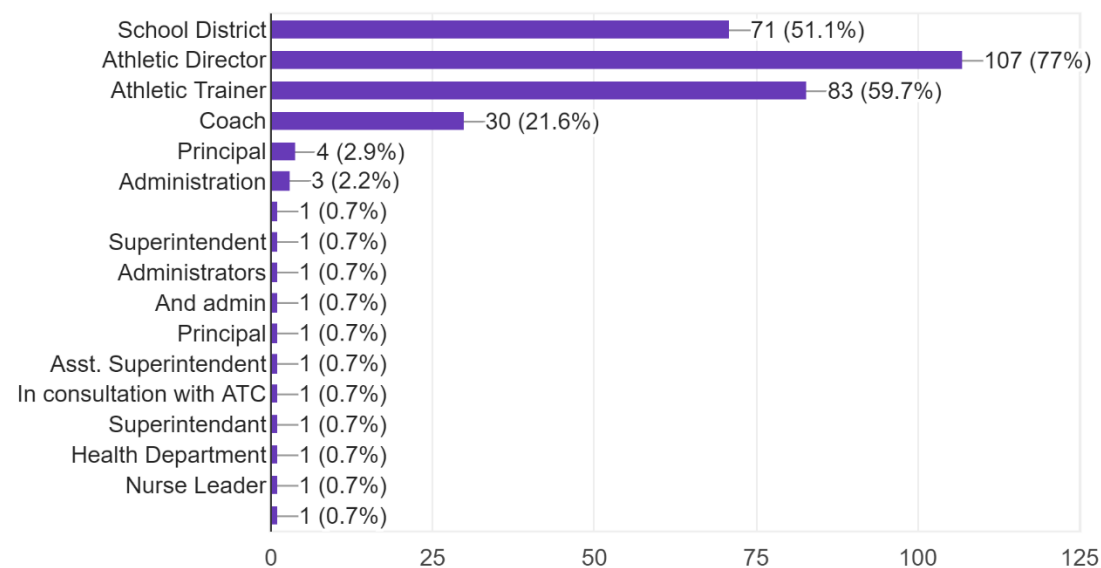
Has your school district established policy criteria for suspending practice or play due to heat?

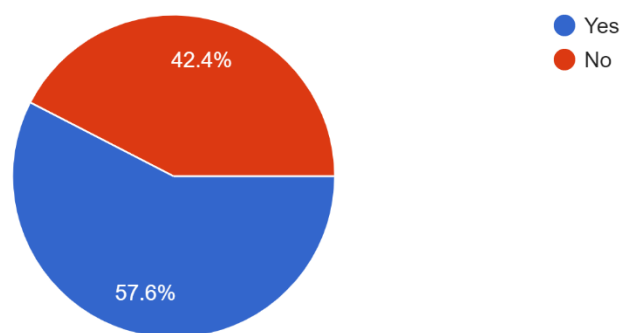
Who is responsible for deciding to suspend practices or contests due to excessive heat?

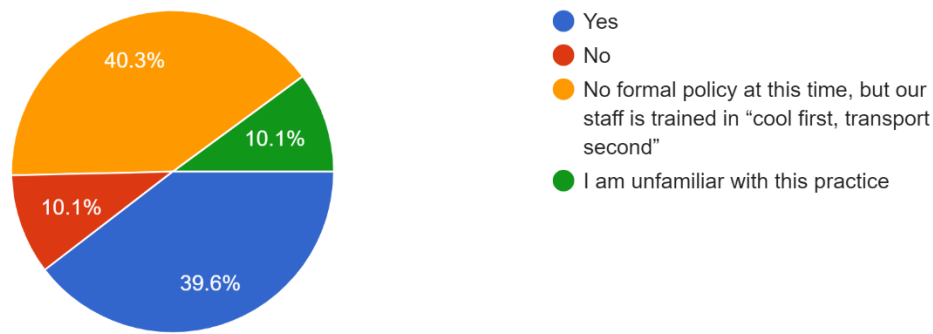
Does your school have a written emergency action plan for the prevention and management of heat related illness for athletes?

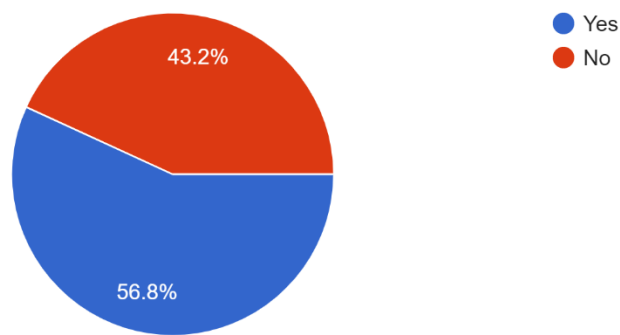

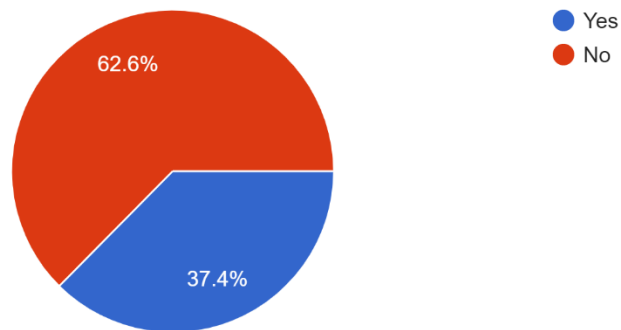

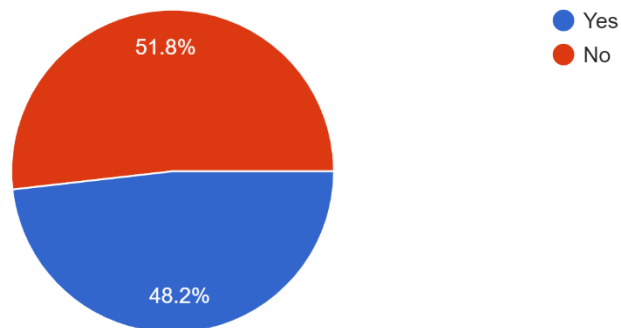

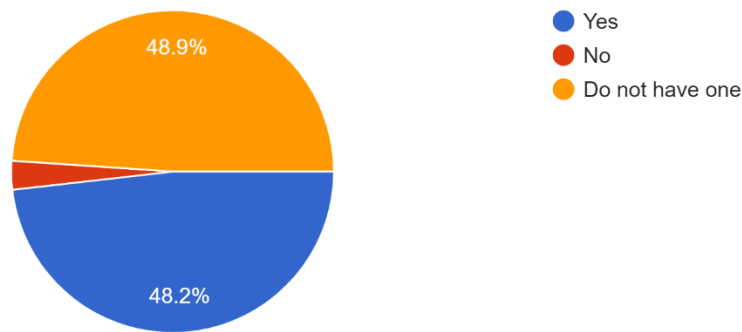

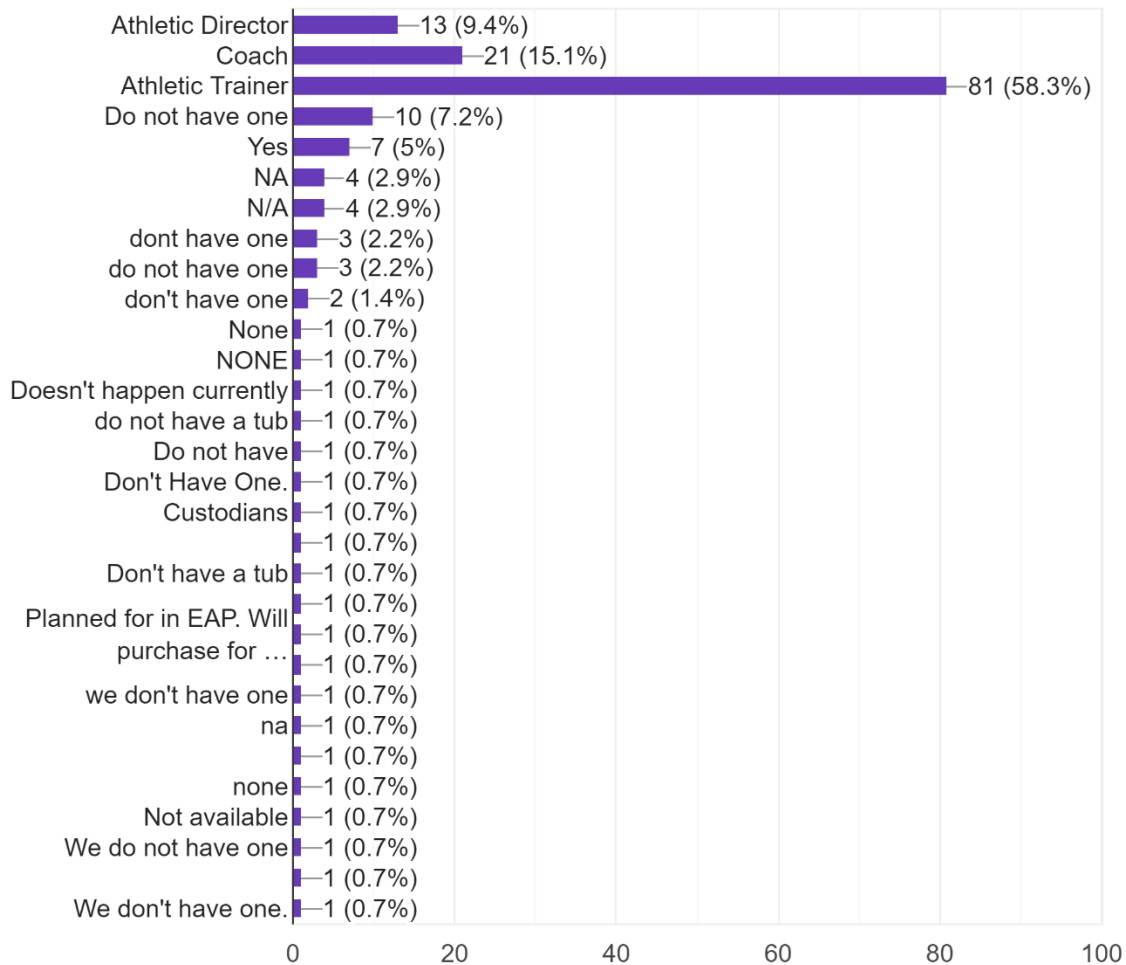

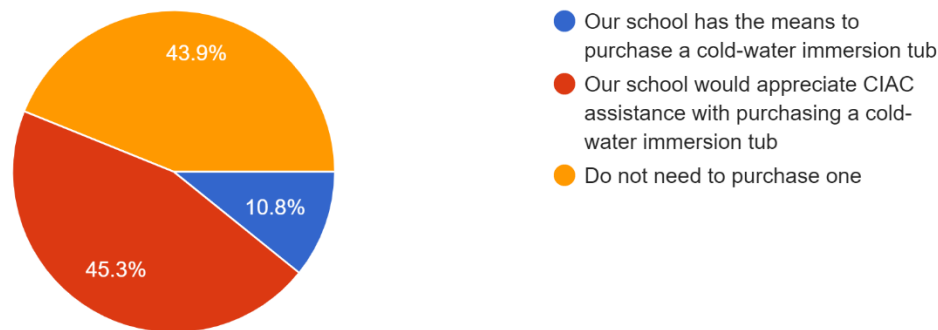
