IEP Quality for School Leadership Teams

School leadership teams play a critical role in ensuring high-quality, legally compliant IEP development and implementation. This **six-hour, in-person training** is designed to support building- and district-level leaders in strengthening systems, collaboration, and oversight related to Connecticut's IEP requirements.
