Leadership Project Description

1. Develop and implement a leadership project that:

- demonstrates your leadership skills utilizing competencies gained from the Leadership Academy; and

- is driven by a personal Theory of Action.

3. Prepare a final presentation, including a four slide PowerPoint, that describes:

- your project and activities
- the results obtained
- what you learned

4. Prepare by September 30, 2022 a one-page leadership project proposal in which you:

- identify, after discussion with your school administrator potential projects, the selected project and the justification for this choice
- explain how your project connects to Meriden District Improvement Plan or to the district's and your school's vision for school and district improvement
- Potential impact on student achievement
- identify the organizational structure, policies, and/or practices that will enhance the school and district goals for student achievement
