You and your school have the power to make a difference this fall.

Voting is one of the most impactful ways to make a difference on the issues that matter to you and your community. Whether your students are eligible to vote or not, they can help get others registered and out to vote in upcoming elections.

We're asking students to take part in the first-ever Democracy Powered by You(th) voter registration competition! Middle level and high schools across the country are competing in multiple categories to demonstrate innovation, creativity, and student leadership for civic engagement from now until Election Day. Prizes, like merch and celebrity shoutouts, will be awarded to students and schools.

How Does It Work?

Step One: Students Sign Up

Students should sign up for the campaign that matches the NASSP student leadership program they are a member of to get started.
