## Mystic Aquarium & Institute for Exploration

3,500 sea creatures take you on a journey into our ocean planet. You'll visit the "Alaskan Coast," a one-of-a-kind, nose-to-nose view of beluga whales and seals in a naturalistic million-gallon habitat and discover "Challenge of the Deep," a unique, interactive experience; you'll explore deep-sea wrecks, ancient sunken artifacts, and bizarre creatures by the abyss.

The Institute for Exploration is the base for famed oceanographer and explorer Dr. Robert Ballard, widely known for his discovery and preservation of the HMS Titanic, Bismarck, PT-109 and many others. Located directly across from the hotel.

## Mystic Seaport — Museum of America & the Sea

Mystic Seaport is our country's leading maritime museum, guardian of the largest collections of boats and nautical photography in the world, and champion of the American maritime experience that connects us all. Take part in all three Mystic Seaport adventures—the unique shipyard where the nearly lost art of wooden shipbuilding endures; exhibit galleries brimming with the culture of seafaring lives; and the bustling 19<sup>th</sup> century village of tall ships and historic buildings. Mystic Seaport is home to the last surviving wooden whaling ship from the great days of sail, the *Charles W. Morgan*. Located just minutes from the hotel.

## Olde Mistick Village

Enjoy a leisurely stroll or shopping along the lanes of this replicated 1720 New England town. An Early American Village, abundant with picturesque settings of flowers, trees, a colonial meeting house, Victorian gazebo, duck ponds and a waterwheel. A world apart from the ordinary mall experience, Olde Mistick Village has become a favorite shopping center for local residents as well as for Mystic's many visitors. Open year round, located directly across from the hotel.

## Downtown Mystic

A true New England seaside experience can be found just around the corner in our own quaint downtown area. Dine along the water, gaze upon tall ships both historic and new, stroll along main street through unique shops, take a boat cruise or just stand on the famous Bascule Drawbridge and discover views that are breathtaking. After 70 years, the bridge is still the main passage across the Mystic River which flows right through the center of town. Located 1 mile from the hotel.

## Denison Pequotsepos Nature Center

Denison Pequotsepos Nature Center is a combination wildlife sanctuary, visitor attraction and educational facility. The Center features all-new exhibits highlighting the habitats and wildlife of southeastern Connecticut, as well as eight miles of trails that wind through a beautiful 300-acre wooded preserve. Located less than 5 minutes from the hotel.

## Stonington Vineyards

Stonington Vineyards is nestled in the Stonington Uplands above the Connecticut Coast where the Long Island Sound meets the open Atlantic. They have been producing award-winning European-style wines for 20 years. Tours and tastings are available 7 days a week. Located just 10 minutes from the hotel.

## Jonathan Edwards Winery

Jonathan Edwards Winery is located in the quaint town of North Stonington, situated on a beautiful 48-acre hilltop overlooking the Atlantic Ocean. Jonathan Edwards handcrafts both premium Napa Valley, California and estate Connecticut wines to highlight each coast's unique climate. Located just 15 minutes from the hotel.
