Reflection # 5: Is the school improvement plan specific enough to monitor carefully? Was the plan modified as it was implemented? How could the plan be improved?
Reflection # 6: Is the team collecting enough data about adult behavior to adequately monitor the effect of the plan? Is the team measuring the impact on the students? How could the team improve both data streams?
