# Appendix K GIRLS BASKETBALL DIVISIONAL CRITERIA NOTES AND EXPLANATIONS

The formula used to place girls basketball teams into divisions for the 2025-26 season included data points from the previous two seasons (2023-24 and 2024-25 power points and tournament success points) in addition to enrollment data from the previous school year (2024-25).

All schools are ranked from numbers 1-178 using the data points from the formula (see below). The divisions were then determined by taking the allotted number of schools starting at the top of the rankings - the top 16 teams are in Division I, the next 38 teams are in Division III, the next 38 teams are in Division IV and the lowest 48 teams are in Division V.

#### **Enrollment:**

The formula starts with each school being assigned a number of points based on its girls enrollment in grades 9-12 for the previous school year. In determining the 2025-26 divisions, each team started with 66% of its 2024-25 girls enrollment as a base. All sports use the previous year's total for divisional purposes.

#### **Power Points:**

The number of Power Points each school has received during the two-year period is added into the enrollment number. Power Points are determined by the same method used in doing the tournament pairing tiebreakers. A school receives one Power Point for each win that each CIAC member school it beat has (10 Power Points for each out-of-state school it beat in a game which counts towards tournament qualifying). For example, if a team wins 10 games and each team it beat had 10 wins, that school would get 100 Power Points.

#### League Multipliers:

The season totals for each of the previous two years are then multiplied by a number assigned to each league. Each league has its own league multiplier. Each league's (schools without a league are considered "Independent") multiplier is generated by league member wins in the CIAC Girls Basketball Tournament over the last two years. Wins in Class LL or Division I are assigned a point value of 5 points. Wins in Class L or Division II are assigned a point value of 4 points. Wins in Class MM or Division III are assigned a point value of 3. Wins in Class M or Division IV are assigned a point value of 2 points. Wins in Class S or Division V are assigned a point value of 1 point. The sum of each league's tournament wins over the last two years are divided by the number of schools in each league and then multiplied by .33 to get each league's multiplier.

Each school's Power Points over the past two seasons are then multiplied by "league multiplier" for each school. Independent schools are assigned a league multiplier using the same formula for all schools that are considered Independent.
