Coaches should register their scrimmage debaters through tabroom.com. We use this system for all of our events. Download our tabroom.com [instructions](#) for more information. On tabroom.com the event name is "CTMSDL Oct 17." There is no cap on the number of teams each school may enter.

Coaches should also register one judge per every 6 debaters who will scrimmage. We'll use CDA varsity debaters as judges first, but we need to have back-up judges. Coaches should make sure their judges understand the information in the CTMSDL Handbook. We will also provide a judges' workshop at the scrimmage.
