



UConn's Administrator Preparation Program Has Reduced Its Tuition & Fees

*Become a Transformational School Leader and Pay Less!**

New for Summer 2024, students in UConn's Administrator Preparation Program will pay a **comprehensive fee of \$970 per credit**. There is not a separate tuition charge for the program, so students will pay a **total cost of \$29,100 over the two-year plan of study**.

About UCAPP:

The University of Connecticut Administrator Preparation Program (UCAPP) is designed for Connecticut-certified educators with at least three years of teaching experience and an interest in school-level leadership. It offers aspiring school administrators an opportunity to earn a sixth-year diploma in educational administration through UConn's Neag School of Education. Graduates also may be eligible for the 092 certification endorsement as an intermediate administrator in the state of Connecticut.
