### BRANDON LEE WHITE



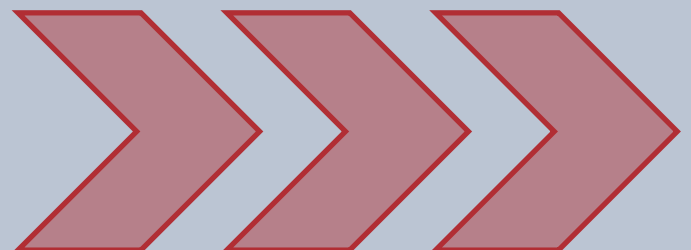

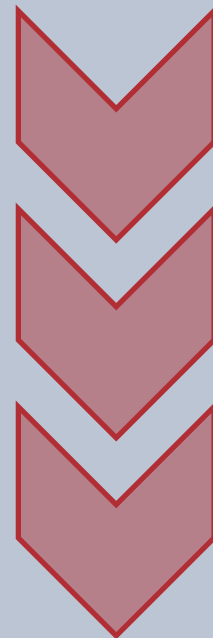

### Non CAS Member Schools

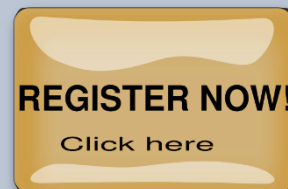
There is an additional \$100 fee per school for non CAS member schools.
