



CIAC 2018 Dedication Award John Fidler



John Fidler was the consummate educator over the course of his life, supporting all students through a variety of roles from the classroom and administrative offices, to the athletic courts and fields. His legacy is reflected in the outpouring of emotion and love demonstrated by the East Hampton community upon his passing in July of last year.

A Connecticut native, John was born in Hartford in 1957 as the son of John and Nellie Fidler. He grew up in South Windsor where, in an early indication of the passions that would define his career, he excelled academically and athletically. He was an All-League basketball player at South Windsor as well as a National Honor Society member. His impact and achievements were recently recognized with his induction into the South Windsor High School Sports Hall of Fame.

John was a graduate of the University of Connecticut where he earned degrees in special education and administration. He also was a founding member of the UConn Ultimate Frisbee Team, a club sport that is still going strong nearly 40 years later.

He then made his mark as a member of the East Hampton school district, serving in countless roles over the course of his 27-year career and impacting innumerable students in each of his positions. He began in East Hampton as a special education teacher serving in that role for fourteen years. He then moved to East Hampton Middle School, first as assistant principal, then principal. Finally, in 2011, John assumed the position of principal at East Hampton High School, a position he held until his passing. His work at East Hampton Middle School was recognized by CAS-CIAC with selection as Outstanding First Year Principal.

While John made his way through various teaching and leadership positions, he was never far from his passion for athletics. He was a highly successful basketball and soccer coach at the high school, and also assumed the position of athletic director for five years. He was an ardent advocate for the value of athletics and all interscholastic programs and had great respect for the mission of the CIAC to promote athletic participation.

John was a highly active individual and could often be found pursuing his passion for mountain biking, hiking, or camping during his free time.

John's death was a devastating loss to the school district and the entire East Hampton community. It was estimated that more than 1,500 people paid their respects at his wake held at the high school. And, this past January, the road leading to the recently-renovated high school was officially renamed "John Fidler Way" and a memorial plaque was placed at the school.

John Fidler was an individual with an intense passion for students, education, and athletics who demonstrated throughout his life and career the positive impact a committed leader can have. The CIAC Boys and Girls Basketball Committees are thrilled to honor John Fidler with the CIAC Boys & Girls Basketball Dedication Award.
