  - Report of Tournament Director – Site Directors – CSGA -- All groups reported all went well at each site.
  - New England Championship – Getting golfers to commit continues to be a problem. Brett Franklin, Conard High School boys golf coach will take over as Connecticut’s representative.  
Please note: Date for next year’s championship is June 20, 2018.
5. Discussion – Where are we now with high school golf and where are we heading?
  - Open Championship – Sub-committee will be formed and chaired by Tom Malin to look into the feasibility of running an Open Championship.
  - Outside play during season – Sub-committee has been formed by the CHSCA to look at expanding the opportunities of golfers to participate in more outside tournaments. CHSCA will develop a proposal for committee consideration.
  - Course Requirements – The committee discussed if course requirements be developed before we contract with any course for four (4) years. Requests could include: adequate parking, warm-up facilities, room / tent for scoring, snack bar, wifi, etc.
  - Two divisions in girls golf – With 57 teams the committee believes there are not enough teams for two divisions at this time.
