Public Act 08-160, "An Act Concerning School Learning Environment", not only postponed the implementation date of the limitation on out-of-school suspensions, but also broadened the definition of bullying and added a number of requirements pertaining to the development and implementation of district policies to address the existence of bullying in CT schools.
