**PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE CAS CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS**  
*(To be voted on by the entire membership)*

**CHANGE #1: ARTICLE IV (Organization) / SECTION C (CAS Board of Directors)**

**Explanation of Change:** To clarify how a job change effects a board member's eligibility to continue to serve on the CAS Board of Directors.

Proposed language (**additions in bold**):

Section C. The Board of Directors of the Connecticut Association of Schools

1. Composition

- d. All directors from B.1.a.iii-vi. will be elected for two year terms. These directors shall not serve consecutively more than two terms of two years each. **If an individual serving on the board changes jobs mid-year and is no longer eligible to fill the position for which he/she was initially elected or appointed, he/she will be allowed to serve out the remainder of the school year. However, he/she will not be allowed to continue to serve the following year even if his/her term has not yet expired.**

**Reason for change:** With the increased turn-over in administrative positions, it became necessary to establish an official protocol for dealing with situations in which an existing board member switches positions mid-year and, as a result, no longer qualifies to fill the board slot for which he/she was initially elected/appointed.
