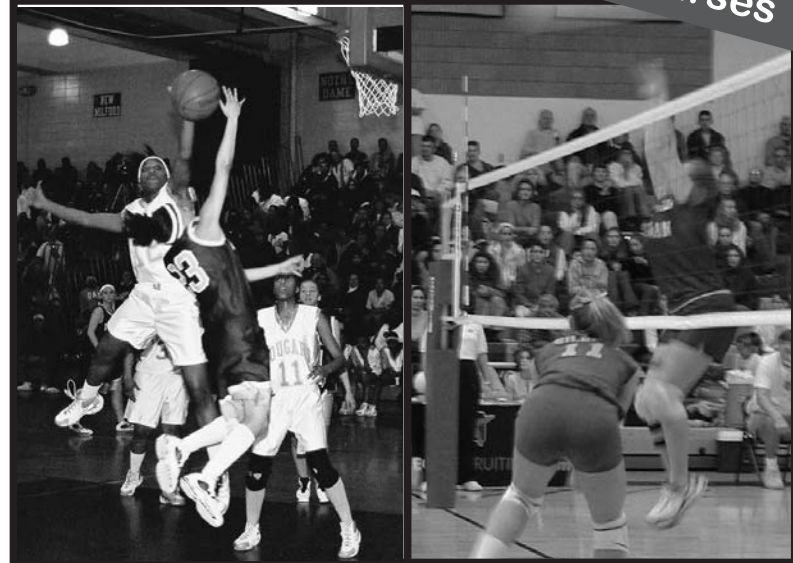

■ What are Coaches Re-certification Courses?

These course offerings provide an opportunity for coaches to experience quality professional development while also satisfying the State Department of Education requirement to obtain fifteen hours of approved course work during the five years for which a coaching permit is approved. Outstanding presenters will provide contemporary, interesting and important information to coaches.

■ Who should attend?

Any coach interested in furthering his/her coaching knowledge and/or any coach interested in satisfying the requirements for renewal of the coaching permit.

■ General description

Interested individuals may sign up for any number of courses. There is no requirement that all the courses or even a minimal number be taken. The topics covered will be coaching female athletes; CIAC rules and regulations; practical sport psychology for middle school and high school programs; team organization as well as team selection; contemporary drug issues; and, sport nutrition.

■ Cost

Individual courses are \$30.00 each. Take any combination of five courses and pay only \$125.

Sign up for any five courses and take advantage of the opportunity to earn all of the required fifteen hours of course work within a four-day time period!

■ Benefits

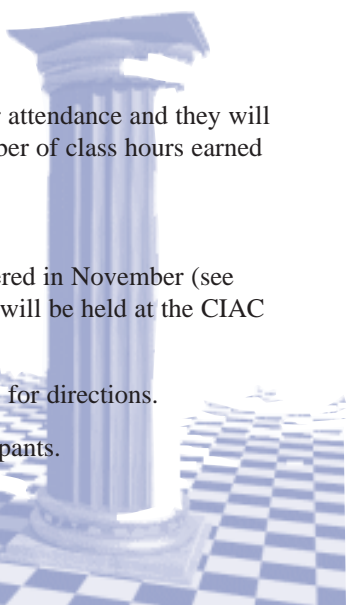
Participants will receive CEUs for their attendance and they will receive a certificate indicating the number of class hours earned toward re-certification.

Connecticut State Department of Education Requirement

A coaching permit shall be renewable every five years upon completion of not less than 15 clock hours of seminars, course work, or workshops which provide information on safe and healthful coaching practices and understanding child and adolescent development. (*SDE Coaching Fact Sheet #105*)
