If you are experiencing an emergency delay due to traffic, please call Dave Nowakowski at (860) 705-2629, and the decision of the CIAC wrestling committee will be final. There is no food permitted in the Field House. Teams/wrestlers bringing coolers will be asked to keep them in the hallway area outside the Field House. Only coaches and wrestlers are permitted within the wrestling area. It will be the responsibility of the winning wrestler to bring his or her bout sheet to the head table.

The grid on reverse of this sheet should allow you to determine where you will be wrestling. In the event that certain mats conclude faster than others, some bouts may need to be shifted near the end of each round.

If one of the 4 divisional champions is a scratch, the other 3 state champs will move up accordingly (even if the $2^{\text {nd }}$ place finisher from the division of the scratched champ has more seed points than any of the remaining 3 champions). The $4^{\text {th }}$ seed will be filled by the $2^{\text {nd }}$ place finisher from the same division as the scratched wrestler, and weight class will be re-bracketed based on the placement of the top 4 seeds, with alternates placed accordingly.
Separation of seeds from same divisional classification is as follows:
$1,6,10,13$
$2,5,9,14$
$3,8,12,15$
